JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. Written statement filed on behalf of respondent i.e. Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.
2. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of result dated 31.08.2018 (Annexure P-8) relating to allotment of LPG Distributorship at Chappar-Mansupur, District Yamunanagar.
3. The grievance of the petitioner is that he was eligible for the allotment still he was not called for draw of lots.
4. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that petitioner was placed in List III and there were 10 candidates in the list I. The respondent was supposed to exhaust List I and thereafter candidates of

other lists could be invited. A candidate from List I has already been selected and he is operating the Gas Agency, thus, petition has rendered infructuous.

5. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner expressed his inability to controvert the submission of learned counsel for the respondent.

6. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
