1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order/list dated nil, Annexure P-7.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner who has minimum qualification in terms of Notification dated 29.08.2022, Annexure P-4, was admitted to the Diploma in Elementary Education in the year 2022, whereafter she has also cleared the additional Hindi exam of 10th on 26.05.2023, from the Punjab School Education Board, Annexure P-3, but is now being not sent for teaching practice in the school on the ground that at the time of her admission she had not cleared the Hindi exam which was, as a matter of fact, only to ensure high quality standards in terms of Clause D of the aforesaid notification. Vide letter dated 03.05.2024, Annexure P-8, addressed to respondent No. 5, who is competent to send for training, the Principal of the

institute requesting him to allow the students to complete their course for better future however no decision thereon has been taken as of now. He, on instructions, submits that a time bound direction be given to respondent No.3 in this regard and to also consider sending the petitioner provisionally for training till final decision is taken.

- 4. Mr. Swapan Shorey, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has no objection to the limited prayer made.
- 5. In view of the aforesaid and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the issue including the request to send her for training provisionally, within ten days, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner.
