Challenge in the present revision is to the order dated 21.08.2014 whereby learned Additional Sessions Judge, Panchakula dismissed the petition bearing registration No. 0000601/2013 titled as '*Rima Wanchoo and another vs. Kamal Nain*' filed under Sections 12, 18, 19, 20 and 22 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 by the respondents.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the appropriate remedy within a period of four weeks from today, in accordance with law, in view of judgment dated 24.04.2023 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **CRM-M-19553-2023** titled as '*Jaspal Kaur alias Pinki and others vs. State of Punjab and another*', wherein it has been held that '*the proceedings under Section 12 of the DV Act are civil in nature, therefore, a petition*

under Section 482 Cr.P.C. or revision under Section 397 Cr.P.C., assailing the order passed in complaint filed under the provisions of DV Act are not maintainable’.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty aforesaid.

Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
