By way of present petition, petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a case arising out of FIR No.87 dated 14.03.2023, under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Mullana, District Ambala.

2. It is stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that a separate petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise has already been filed, though the same has not been listed. Learned counsel further submits that he has brought a demand draft of ₹10 lacs for making the payment of remaining amount today also.

3. Learned counsel for the complainant has no objection to grant the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. Since, the major amount, as per the settlement effected between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, has already been paid by the petitioner to the complainant, therefore, the present petition is allowed.

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5. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer, subject to the condition that he shall join the investigation, as and when required by the Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main petition has been allowed, therefore, the accompanied application(s) stand disposed of.
