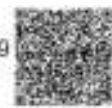

By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
006	06.01.2024	224 and 353 IPC	Ferozepur Jhirka, District Nuh, Haryana

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance to the order dated 02.07.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioner may be confirmed.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harpal Singh



has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required for further investigation.

4. Heard.

5. During the course of hearing on 02.07.2024 the following order was passed:-

“ Status report dated 24.06.2024 in the form of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Firozpur Jhirka, District Nuh, has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. It is, inter alia, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has not committed any crime nor the alleged occurrence ever took place and with mala fide intentions a false report has been given in connivance with the decree holder to pressurize the petitioner.

3. Learned State counsel, by referring to the reply submitted by the State, has opposed the application for grant of bail, however, perusal of the reply would reveal that the documents have already been taken in possession by the police.

4. In these circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. List on 18.07.2024.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 02.07.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 02.07.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this



case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
