The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to treat the petitioner regular as has been done in the case of other persons vide order along with list dated 23.12.2011 (Annexure P-9) as the petitioner also fulfills the qualification required under the Notification dated 17.11.2011, conveyed to the respondent – department through letter dated 19.11.2011, without conveying any formal order to the petitioner but now conveyed through reply dated 31.08.2021 (Annexure P-16), in response to the legal representation dated 20.07.2021 (Annexure P-15) and also to grant regular pay-scale along with all monetary benefits/arrears to the petitioner from the due dates along with interest on arrears, when the regular pay-scale was granted to other similarly situated contractual employees by quashing the action of respondent to the extent of not regularizing the service of the petitioner when services of other employees were regularized vide order dated 23.12.2011 (Annexure P-9) and letter dated 31.08.2021 (Annexure P-16), rejecting the legal representation.



After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file afresh one, on the same cause of action, with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
