Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction in the nature of mandamus, directing respondents No.2 & 3 to safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioner, which is in danger due to the actions of respondents No.4 to 9. These respondents are allegedly preventing the petitioner from meeting his minor daughters, Manseerat Kaur and Prabhleen Kaur, who are being unlawfully detained by respondents No.4 to 9. The petitioner has submitted representation dated 01.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) for consideration.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has filed a representation dated 01.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if his



representation dated 01.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) is decided in a time bound manner.

Heard.

After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali is directed to decide the representation dated 01.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within one month from today, in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
