Challenge in the present petition is to the orders dated 29.11.2018, 14.01.2019 and 27.02.2019 and all other consequential proceedings arising after the passing of the above said orders passed by the Punjab State Commission for NRIs, Chandigarh.

Vide order dated 19.03.2024 passed by this Court, on the request of learned respective counsel, the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for exploring the possibility of an amicable resolution of the dispute.
