1. This order will dispose of two writ petitions i.e. CWP-11653-  
2024 filed by petitioner Ishwinder Singh Hanjra and CWP-11763-2024



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filed by three petitioners, namely, Ekas Jandu, Abhiroop Singh and Sanchit Batra.

2. A common prayer has been made in both the said writ petitions to the effect that the respondent authorities be directed to allow the petitioners to appear and take examinations of Third Professional Exams, First Part,, which are scheduled to commence from 21.05.2024.

3. Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.5, on instructions from Mr. Sandeep Kaushal, Dean, has submitted that the petitioners in order to be eligible to sit in the exams, are required to have the requisite attendance, eligibility as per the rules and the minimum marks in internal assessment and has further submitted that none of the four petitioners are eligible to appear in all the subjects. It is further submitted that the petitioners are eligible to appear in some of the subjects and the petitioners, who are eligible in all respects in the said subjects, would be permitted to give the exams in those particular subjects. It is stated that respondent No.5 would forward the examination forms to respondent No.4 with respect to those petitioners and for those subjects for which they are eligible during the course of the day. It is further stated that Ishwinder Singh Hanjra, who is the petitioner in CWP-11653-2024, is not eligible to appear in any of the subjects.

4. Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.4 has submitted that in case, the examination forms of the petitioners for the relevant subjects are forwarded to them during the course of the day, then, the roll numbers would be issued to the petitioners for the said subjects



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until 12.00 noon on Monday.

5. Learned counsel for respondents No.4 and 5 have submitted that the petitioners be also directed to fully cooperate to carry out the said exercise.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners would help the respondents No.4 and 5 in each & every way to carry out the above-said exercise and has submitted that the petitioners are satisfied with the statements made on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5 and has submitted that in view of the same, the present writ petitions be disposed of, but the respondents No.4 and 5 be bound by the statements made before this Court.

7. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present petitions are disposed of, in terms of the above-said statements of the parties and all the parties would be bound by the said statements made before this Court.
