Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that as per the advertisement published by the respondents for inviting application for the post of Veterinary surgeon vide advertisement No.08.2021 dated 23.11.2021 (Annexure P/1), two times of the number of vacancies the candidates were to be called but after the result of the written examination declared and the candidates were called for interview, the said condition has not been followed by the respondents, which is causing prejudice to the petitioners as the petitioners have not been called for interview for the post in question.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Vibha Tewari, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that without even raising the said grievance with the respondent-Commission by way of representation, the present



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petition has been filed by the petitioners, which should not be entertained.

Faced with this situation , learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents by way of filing an appropriate representation and the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner so that petitioners does not suffer any prejudice.

Learned State counsel submits that in case, any representation is received from the petitioners, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 02 weeks from the date of receipt of such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
