1. Through the instant petition, filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C., a prayer is made for grant of relief of regular bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.249, dated 21.12.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Khanna, Punjab.
2. Short reply dated 19.10.2024, by way of affidavit of Mr. Amritpal Singh Bhaati, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana, on behalf of the respondent-State of Punjab, along with custody Certificate dated 20.10.2024, qua the petitioner, furnished by learned State counsel today, in the Court. The same are taken on the record. Copies thereof, supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.
3. Learned State counsel, on instruction imparted to him by ASI Charanjit Singh, submits that out of total 10 prosecution witnesses, 04 witnesses have been examined, 04 witnesses have been given up and as on date, only 02 witnesses are left for examination.

4. In view of the fact that the trial is moving in right direction, therefore, this Court is not inclined to consider the case of the present petitioner, to grant the asked for relief (supra).
5. Accordingly, the instant petition is, hereby, **dismissed**.
