The instant petition has been instituted under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.6 and 7 being the successful Contractors having been awarded the work of lifting of food grains at Grain Market, Mallanwala, Grain Market, Kamalwala and Grain Market, Faridewala Center to undertake the said work for lifting of the food grains/wheat bags purchased by the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that with regard to his grievance, he has submitted representation dated 12.05.2024 (Annexure P-11) upon respondent-authorities but no action has been taken by the respondent-authorities.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No. 1 to 5 only.



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Ms. Harpriya Khaneka, DAG. Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 only.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.5 –the District Manager, PUNGRAIN, Ferozepur is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 12.05.2024 (Annexure P-11) in a time bound manner.

Learned State Counsel does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.5 –the District Manager, PUNGRAIN, Ferozepur to consider and decide the representation dated 12.05.2024 (Annexure P-11) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
