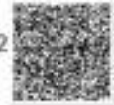

By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance to the order dated 24.07.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner



has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioner may be confirmed.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harpal Singh has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required for further investigation.

4. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the petition by arguing that the petitioner has duped the complainant and there is one more FIR registered against the petitioner, although, he is on interim bail therein.

5. Heard.

6. During the course of hearing on 24.07.2024, the following order was passed:-

“1. Status report dated 12.07.2024 already filed in the form of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-1, Patiala, District Patiala, is ordered to be taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. Heard.

3. Considering the respective submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for the complainant, it is deemed appropriate that the petitioner should join the investigation first, before deciding the petition on merits.

4. Accordingly, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within 07 days from today and co-operate in the same. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. List on 01.08.2024.”



7. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 24.07.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 24.07.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

8. The petition stands allowed.
