In the present petition, the claim of the petitioner is that his medical reimbursement has not been decided in accordance with law and the amount incurred on the treatment, which amount has been paid by the petitioner to the hospital, which hospital is an impaneled hospital, the full refund has not been made to him by the respondents which is causing prejudice to the petitioner, hence, the respondents be directed to grant the petitioner the full reimbursement of the medical expenses incurred by the petitioner on his treatment.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that with the writ petition, after the payment of approximately ₹4,00,000/- out of the total amount claimed as a medical reimbursement, no representation has been filed by the petitioner raising any grievance and in case, the petitioner is aggrieved in any manner and files any representation claiming any amount by giving due reasons, the same will be analyzed and considered and an appropriate order on such grievance raised will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief, the same will be granted to the petitioner, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
