Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for issuance of a roving writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of alleged detenu, Ranjit Singh, who is stated to be in the illegal custody of officials of Mullanpur Police Station.

2. Mr. Amish Sharma, Advocate (P/4902/2018), Mobile No.9888522666 present in Court is appointed as Amicus Curiae to assist the Court on behalf of the petitioner. He shall be compensated by High Court Legal Services Committee, Chandigarh, as per rules.

3. Learned Amicus Curiae contends that father of petitioner, namely, Ranjit Singh and her brother Kamaljeet Singh Kaler have been detained by the police officials of Police Station Mullanpur, Tehsil Kharar, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dalwinder Singh, has apprised the Court that Kamaljeet Singh Kaler was called to Police Station regarding investigation of FIR No.0059,

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dated 04.05.2024 and in this regard, DDR No.035, dated 12.05.2024 was entered. He also acknowledged that Kamaljeet Singh Kaler was accompanied with Manjit Singh at his own; but the latter was never called by police. He further stated that after recording the statement of Kamaljeet Singh Kaler, both were allowed to go and even their counsel namely Mr. Mohit Jain was also present at that time. It is specifically stated that as on today, none of them is in police custody.

4. In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter. Consequently, the petition stands disposed off.
5. Needless to say that petitioner may take recourse to the remedy as per law, if an occasion so arises.
6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
