Therefore, since a conscious decision on such resolutions has to be taken by the State Government, as such, whether the decision on such resolutions has been taken by the Government concerned, therefore, the learned State counsel is directed to apprise this Court on the subsequent date of hearing.

The learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab and Mr. Neeraj Sharma, counsel appearing for respondent – Improvement Trust, on instructions of the parties, submit that approval to the said resolutions has been made by the State Government. Therefore, the learned counsel for the petitioners therebys seeks that the petition be disposed of.

3. The petition is disposed of accordingly. However, the respondents are directed to, within a period of one week from today, issue the requisite 'No Objection Certificates' to the present petitioners, but subject to, in terms of the resolutions respectively bearing resolutions numbers 27 and 28, all the requisite charges being deposited by the petitioners before the competent authority.
