1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent.

2. Learned counsel inter alia contends that both the petitioners are senior citizens and paternal uncles of respondent No.5, who has been continuously subjecting them to mental torture and harassment including threatening them with dire consequences. Learned counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to Annexure P-1, representation dated 01.05.2024 moved by the petitioners to respondent No.3-SSP Fatehgarh Sahib as they apprehend that they could be done to death by the private respondent.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that they would restrict their prayer and will



be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to decide their representation dated 01.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) expeditiously.

- 4. Notice of motion to the official respondents.
- 5. At the asking of Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, Dy. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.
- 6. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to look into the representation dated 01.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law at the earliest to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondent.
