By way of this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer is made to quash order dated 22.11.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by trial Court, whereby bail bonds/surety bonds of the petitioner were cancelled in SC No.217-2022 titled as "State Vs. Kuldeep Singh" arising out of FIR No.60 dated 03.08.2021 under Section 379 IPC & 21(1) Mines and Minerals Act registered at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran.

2. Learned counsel contends that petitioner was on bail and was appearing before the Court regularly. However, on 22.11.2023, he could not appear as he skipped the date. His bail was cancelled and warrants of arrest have been issued. Learned counsel contends that petitioner is ready to surrender before the Court and he may be provided necessary protection.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Vinay Kumar Malhotra, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State.



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5. This petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to surrender before the Trial Court concerned within a period of 15 days from today. On his such appearance, the Trial Court will initiate proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. against the petitioner and after disposal thereof, shall admit the petitioner to bail.

6. It is made clear that till the disposal of proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C., petitioner shall not be taken into custody. If in the meantime, petitioner is sought to be arrested on account of warrants of arrest having being issued against him, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer.
