1. This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to accept the thesis of the petitioner. Other prayers have also been made.
2. Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.1 has submitted that in the present case, a detailed order dated 08.05.2024 (Annexure P-28) has been passed by respondent No.1 rejecting the claim of the petitioner and the said order has not been challenged by the petitioner in the present petition.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after laying challenge to the said order and also after giving full and better particulars.
4. In view of the above-said statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
