1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to take legal action against the private respondent, who has defrauded the petitioner and prepared fake documents with an attention to falsely implicate him in criminal cases.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he would restrict his prayer and will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to decide the representation dated 18.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

4. At the asking of Court, Ms. Trishanjali Sharma, Dy. Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.



5. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – DCP, Sonipat to look into the representation dated 18.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law at the earliest.
