As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Learned counsel further submitted that the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellants 1, 2 and 3 in equal shares, for & on behalf of all the claimants, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit three cheques; two in the sum of Rs.1,67,000/- each favouring appellants 2 and 3 and one in the sum of Rs.1,66,000/- favouring appellant No.1, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques/drafts from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheques/drafts bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellant/appellants.

Appeal stands disposed of.
