The petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents so as to enable it to take physical possession of the assets.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner-bank had issued notice under Section 13(2) of the SARFAESI Act, 2002 (for short, 'the Act, 2002'), to respondents No.3 and 4 on 06.09.2021, while the notice under Section 13(4) of the Act, 2002, was issued on 22.12.2021. The District Magistrate had passed an order on 18.04.2022 under Section 14 of the Act, 2002, for handing over the physical possession of the premises to the petitioner, but the physical possession has not been handed over for want of police help.

3. Issue notice to respondents No.1 and 2 only at this stage.

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4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Anant Kataria, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. He submits that all steps would be taken in accordance with law to comply with the order dated 18.04.2022 passed by the District Magistrate under Section 14 of the Act, 2002.

5. In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of.
