The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 08.06.2010 (Annexure P-9), whereby the claim of the petitioner for regularization and subsequent promotion over and above respondent No.4, who is junior to the petitioner, has been rejected.
