1. Counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners aged about 20 years are living together and are into live in relationship against the wishes of respondent No.4 to 8, who are extending threats to cause harm to the petitioners. That in this regard, representation dated 14.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) is already given to respondent No.2 but the authorities have failed to take any action.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

4. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur to consider representation dated 14.05.2024 (Annexure

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P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 9 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
