KIRTI SINGH. J.(Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for seeking issuance of an appropriate order or direction to the officials against respondents No.2 and 3, for taking action against respondents No.4 and 13 for unlawfully making an attempt to trespass to the land of the petitioner side with a motive to dispossess them from their land.

2. Learned State counsel while placing reliance upon the status report has contended that the officers of the Revenue Department were acting in pursuance to the official orders received from District Magistrate Amritsar to remove illegal possession of shamlat land, belonging to Gram Panchayat. He

further contended that the officers were acting in their official capacity and in accordance with law, however, the petitioner and his associates illegally obstructed the officers from performing their duties. He also contended that the allegations are false and without merit, hence, the petition should be dismissed as no valid cause for relief exists.

3. In view of the above, no further action is required in this case and the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
