VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 06.03.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Jalandhar whereby the petition filed by the petitioner under Section 22 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 for eviction of respondents from the house owned by the petitioner has been dismissed.
2. Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 and 2 has submitted that the petitioner has died and thus, the present petition, in all probability, has been rendered infructuous.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is not aware of the said fact and thus, the present petition may be disposed of as

having been rendered infructuous at this stage but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to revive the petition in case any cause of action survives.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present case, in case, any cause of action survives in the same.
