Prayer in the present writ petition is for directing the respondents to restore the security of the petitioner which was withdrawn on 09.05.2024.

A short reply on behalf of respondents by way of an affidavit of Sukhjinder Pal Singh, P.P.S. Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Attari, Amritsar City has been filed wherein it has been reported that the matter was inquired into and statements of various persons was recorded. It has been reported that the petitioner does not have any residential house at Village Kamaske and his Aadhar Card is also having the address of Chandigarh. During the enquiry, the petitioner was contacted for getting recorded his statement, however he refused to get his statement recorded. He was also called upon to

furnish information regarding any threat call or letter or any complaint having been filed by him before any Police Station but the same was also not furnished. The relevant extract of the said short reply is as under:-

“4. That the Station House Officer, Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar (Rural) has reported therein that enquiry relating to the aforesaid subject matter was conducted through ASI Lakhwinder Singh No. 73/ASR-R, who visited village Kamaske and recorded the statements of watchman Ravel Singh, Member Panchayat Saun Singh and Baaj Singh son of Sarwan Singh of Village Kamaske, who had stated that the petitioner was ex-sarpanch of Village Kamaske and he had shifted to Chandigarh with his family from quite a long time and he rarely visit village.

5. That it has been further reported that the petitioner is not having any residential house at village Kamaske and his Aadhar Card is also having the address of Chandigarh. During the enquiry ASI Lakhwinder Singh contacted on the mobile No. 84600-00014 of the petitioner for recording his statement but the petitioner refused to give any statement and when he was asked to provide an information regarding threat call or letter or he has filed any complaint at any Police Station, the petitioner did not provide any information. It has been further reported that the petitioner is permanently residing at Chandigarh and he is required to approach Chandigarh administration for the security. The true translation of the aforesaid report dated 15.07.2024 submitted by the Station House Officer, Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar (Rural) is attached herewith for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court as
