1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of direction to the official respondents to decide legal notice dated 24.09.2019 (Annexure P-3).
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that appropriate direction be issued to the official respondents to decide the representation dated 24.09.2019 (Annexure P-3) moved at the instance of petitioner by passing a speaking order expeditiously.
3. Prayer seems to be justified.
4. Upon advance notice, Mr. Devinder Bir Singh, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab appears on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 4 and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.
5. In view of the aforesaid, but without going into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. The Additional Director General of Police (Security) Punjab, Police

Headquarter Sector 9, Chandigarh to look into the representation dated 24.09.2019 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 08 (eight) weeks’ from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
