JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to re-issue her passport.
2. The petitioner has applied for passport with name of single parent. She claims that a matrimonial dispute is pending between her parents, thus, it is not possible for her to get consent of her father. The dispute is pending in a Family Court at Canada as well as at Family Court, Sunam (District Sangrur).
3. Notice of motion.
4. Ms. Sehej Sandhawalia, Central Govt. Counsel for the respondents-Union of India, who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice and waives service.
5. With the consent of both the parties, the matter is taken up today itself for final disposal.



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6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that petitioner has not submitted any documents disclosing pending matrimonial dispute between her parents, thus, consent of both parties is required. If she submits documents to the effect that matrimonial dispute is pending between her parents, the Competent Authority would consider her case and pass an appropriate order

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.

8. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to petitioner to appear before the passport authority on 14.06.2024 alongwith requisite documents. On doing so, the passport authority would pass an appropriate order within eight weeks from 14.06.2024.
