The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing DDR No.28 dated 16.06.2015 registered under Sections 307, 341, 336, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur in case FIR No.90 dated 16.06.2015 registered under Sections 307, 336, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 21.05.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short affidavit dated 26.08.2024 by way of an affidavit of Gurdeep Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police Zira, District Ferozepur has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the
