RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 26.07.2023 passed in CWP-12419-2023.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of respondent No.3, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents have submitted that the order dated 26.07.2023 passed in CWP-12419-2023 has since been complied with and after making necessary calculations, the amount has been paid to the petitioner, vide cheque No.002048 dated 24.05.2024.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, it would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
