1. By way of present petition, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 24.01.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-27929-2022.

2. Mr. Rajiv Rattan, IAS, has joined the Court proceedings through video conferencing and he assures that the statutory appeal pending at the instance of petitioner herein shall be adjudicated upon finally within a period of two weeks from today.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.

4. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the
aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at
liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the
erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- as
costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation
expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
