Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that without giving any reason, the impugned order dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P-13) has been passed declining the claim of regularization under the Policy dated 01.10.2003 (Annexure P-4). Learned counsel submits that the totally cryptic and non-speaking order has been passed and no reason has been given for declining the claim of the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.
