By way of present criminal writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner prays for issuing a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty from the hands of respondent No.4, who is harassing and humiliating him.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has made representation dated 20.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2 – the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, but no action has been taken so far.

3. Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only.

4. Mr. Vinay Kumar Malhotra, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 - State.

5. This petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to look into the representation (Annexure P-2) and dispose of the same within 15 days

positively, in accordance with law. In the meantime, respondent No.2 is also directed to assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioner, if any and then provide him necessary protection, as per requirement.
