After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present impugned order dated 26.07.2017, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-9 is appealable and the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty to file an appeal and the respondents be directed to decide the said appeal on merits as the other employee, accused of the same allegations has already been given all the benefits which have been denied to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any appeal is filed by the petitioner against the impugned order dated 26.07.2017 (Annexure P-9), appropriate order on merits will be passed within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of such appeal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty to file appropriate appeal against the order.

Ordered accordingly.
