This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC to call the status report from respondents No. 2 to 4 on the complaint dated 01.05.2024 (Annexure P-8) submitted by the petitioner against respondents No. 5 to 10.

2. Heard.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner happens to be the owner in possession of the property in question but the private respondents in connivance with each other with criminal intent have altered the revenue record at the back of the petitioner in illegal manner and aggrieved by the same, the petitioner had been approaching the police authorities for taking appropriate legal



action but till date no action thereon has been taken. He further contends that the petitioner had even moved a latest representation dated 01.05.2024 (Annexure P-8) to the Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Headquarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh, but the same is still pending decision.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. He submits that the aforesaid representation will be considered and dealt with in accordance with the law.

7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-the Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Headquarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 01.05.2024 (Annexure P-8), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.



8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
