1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 13.05.2025 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Chandigarh, and the undertaking dated 13.05.2025 given by one Uday Bhan, in CS No.826-2015.
2. Perusal of the case file shows that the order qua which the contempt is alleged, has been passed by the Civil Court. The aforesaid undertaking was also given before the Civil Court. The said Court is having sufficient power and wide competence to get its own order executed. Therefore, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition any more.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to raise her grievance before the concerned Court, but in accordance with law.
