1. On 27.03.2017, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Perusal of the record reveals that notice of motion was issued on 19.10.2015 and the sentence of the petitioner was suspended. Thereafter none appeared on behalf of the petitioner on 17.12.2015, 13.07.2016, 21.09.2016, 03.10.2016 and even today. In view of above, last opportunity is granted to learned counsel for the petitioner to address arguments, failing which this case shall be decided on merits. Adjourned to 03.07.2017”.
2. Thereafter there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 03.07.2017, 25.09.2017, 06.10.2017, 29.08.2018, 20.12.2018, 11.02.2019, 10.08.2022, 02.08.2023 and 17.10.2023. It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present case before this Court.
3. At the very outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that he has no instructions in the present case. Consequently, the order dated 19.10.2015 is ordered to be recalled and the

petitioner is directed to surrender before the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate Fatehgarh Sahib.

4. The concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate, is directed to issue Non-bailable warrants against the petitioner and to commit him custody to serve the remaining sentence.

5. The present petition is ordered to be dismissed for want of non-prosecution.
