The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to the First Appellate Court to release the 20% compensation in favour of the petitioner/complainant which has been deposited by the respondent-accused in CRA-86-2023 after his conviction in a case under Section 138 of NI Act titled as Mir Chand Sharma Vs. Ajit Singh Rana vide judgment dated 14.02.2023.

I am not inclined to order the release of the compensation amount at this stage. However, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the Appellate Court to conclude the hearing in the appeal within a period of 04 weeks from the next date of hearing fixed before it.
