KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. Counsel for the petitioners submits that respondent No.5 is real brother of both the petitioners. That their father gave 15 acres of land to respondent No.5 while 6 acres each of land was given to both the petitioners but respondent No.5 is not allowing the petitioners to enter their land measuring 12 acres. That father of the petitioners during his lifetime filed eviction petition seeking ejectment of respondent No.5 from aforesaid 12 acres of land. Counsel for the petitioners further submits respondent No.5 is also extending threats to cause physical harm to the petitioners in case they tried to enter their land measuring 12 acres and in this regard representation dated 08.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) is given by the petitioners to respondent No.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Sirsa but the police authorities failed to take any action in accordance with law to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from



hands of respondent No.5. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioners will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to look into the matter and decide representation dated 08.05.2024 (Annexure P-1).

2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Neeraj Sheoran, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and submits that in case any such representation is pending, the same will be considered and decided by the competent authority in a time bound manner.
4. In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to consider and decide representation dated 08.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
