1. Present petition has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No.53 dated 07.04.2019 under Sections 22, 29 and 61 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Dhanaula, District Baranala.
2. Counsel for the State on instructions from HC Ranjit Singh submits that not only challan stands presented rather charges have also been framed and the trial stands concluded as eight out of 12 witnesses have already been examined.
3. In view thereof and in the considered opinion of this Court, present petition has been rendered infructuous.
4. Ordered accordingly. However, petitioner is granted liberty to raise all pleas before the trial Court at an appropriate stage in accordance with law.
