Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent No. 2 to conduct fair and transparent inquiry in case FIR No. 0097 dated 05.10.2023 (Annexure P-3) registered under Sections 498-A of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Women, District Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that nothing survives in the present petition as the Investigating Agency has already concluded the investigation and submitted the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. before the jurisdictional Court on 23.11.2023 and as regard to addition of Section 406 of Indian Penal Code is concerned, learned trial Court is seized of the matter. Charges have already been framed by learned trial Court and now the case is fixed for prosecution evidence. As such, learned State counsel do not

intend to file reply as the facts are apparent on record.

In view of the fact that Investigating Agency has already concluded the investigation and filed the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. before the jurisdictional Court and trial of the case is progressing. No further directions are required to be issued in the present petition and the same is hereby disposed of accordingly.
