The petitioners seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.106 dated 14.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.05.2024, the petitioner have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

An affidavit dated 21.07.2024 by way of an affidavit of Sukhnaaz Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Div. Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 29.05.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on



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joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
