Learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over demand draft No.071303, dated 03.02.2024 for an amount of ₹75,000/- favouring the complainant- Kamla, drawn at HDFC Bank, which has been accepted by Shri Pawan Kumar Hooda, Advocate on behalf of the complainant. The copy of said demand draft has been placed on file.

2. Learned counsel for the complainant concedes that as per settlement effected between the parties, the entire amount has been paid and she has no objection to make absolute the order dated 25.08.2022, vide which interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for both the parties have also agreed that a separate petition shall be filed, so as to quash the FIR in question, based on compromise.

4. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the order dated 25.08.2022, whereby petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail in a case arising out of FIR No.801 dated 17.12.2021, under Sections 120-B, 201, 409, 420, 467 and 468 of IPC, registered at Police Station

Kharkhoda, District Sonipat, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
