1. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 a male aged about 30 years and petitioner No.2 a female aged about 26 years are into live in relationship and both of them are unmarried. It is further submitted that the aforesaid relationship is being opposed by respondents No.4 to 8 who have also threatened to cause harm to the petitioner and in this regard representation dated 11.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) is submitted to respondent No.2 but the authorities failed to take any action in this regard.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.
4. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this

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petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur to consider representation dated 11.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 8 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
