1. In the present petition, the grievance is being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner is working as a Teacher in the Elementary Teacher Training (ETT) Cadre, but her seniority has not been fixed in accordance with the merit which she obtained in the selection process, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner..
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the seniority of the petitioner be fixed in accordance with her merit along with the consequential promotion and increments.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised through representation dated 01.04.2024 (Annexure P/6), which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.
4. Notice of motion.



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5. Mr. Satnam Preet Singh Chauhan, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, representation dated 01.04.2024 (Annexure P/6) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

8. Ordered accordingly.
