To await the report of the Mediator, adjourned to 07.08.2024.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer to join investigation within one week or as and when subsequently required thereafter. In the event of his arrest, the Investigating/Arresting Officer shall release the petitioner on interim bail on furnishing personal/surety bonds to his/her satisfaction. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.'

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jasvir Singh, at the very outset informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on the ground that son of the petitioner has obtained uncontested divorce from the concerned jurisdictional Court in Canada and he beaten the complainant in this regard, thereafter, she had called the police help line No.911 in Canada.

In view of the statement of learned State counsel, order dated 22.05.2024 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
