As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative of the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹5,00,000/- (₹ Five Lakh Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant Nos.2 to 4, in equal shares.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed-cheques in the sum of ₹5,00,000/- in the respective names of appellant Nos.2 to 4 in equal shares with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 14.03.2024, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

It has been stated by learned counsel for the appellants that name of Kirna @ Kirna Devi - appellant No.2 is in fact Kirna Devi and that now she is using her name only Kirna Devi and that Aadhar Card is also in the name of Kirna Devi and that her bank account is also in the same name. He has also produced photocopies of her Aadhar Card and bank account, which are taken on the record.

Hence, as prayed for, Insurance Company is directed to issue cheque regarding share of appellant No.2 in the name of Kirna Devi.

It has also been stated by learned counsel for the appellants that name of Satpal @ Pala Ram - appellant No.3 is in fact Pala Ram and that now he is using his name only Pala Ram and that Aadhar Card is also in the name of Pala Ram and that his bank account is also in the same name. He has also produced photocopies of Aadhar Card and bank account of appellant No.3 – Pala Ram S/o Bharat Lal, which are taken on the record.

Hence, as prayed for, Insurance Company is directed to issue cheque regarding share of appellant No.3 in the name of Pala Ram S/o Bharat Lal.

It has also been stated by learned counsel for the appellants that name of Surender @ Sulender Kumar - appellant No.4 is in fact Sulender Kumar and that now he is using his name only Sulender Kumar and that Aadhar Card is also in the name of Sulender Kumar and that his bank account is also in the same name. He has also produced photocopies of

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Aadhar Card and bank account of appellant No.4 - Sulender Kumar S/o Bharat Lal, which are taken on the record.

Hence, as prayed for, Insurance Company is directed to issue cheque regarding share of appellant No.4 in the name of Sulender Kumar S/o Bharat Lal.
