This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C has been filed for issuance of directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 for handing over the investigation of FIR No. 124 dated 20.10.2023 U/s 409,420, 120-B IPC registered at PS Phul, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1) against the respondents No. 7 and 8 and unknown persons to the Central Bureau of Investigation and for issuance of direction U/s 439(2) Read with 482 Cr.P.C for cancellation of Bail granted to Deepak Kumar alias Deepu vide Order dated 06.11.2023 in BA/4001/2023 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 2.11.2023 (Annexure P-2) within a time bound manner.



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3. Without advertent to the merits of the case, particularly qua the allegations of the faulty investigation conducted by the Agency in the instant FIR, the respondent No.2-The Chief Director, Vigilance Bureau, SAS Nagar is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 02.11.2023 (Annexure P-2) by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the counsel for the petitioner within one week thereafter.

5. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
