Prayer made in the present writ petition is to direct the Police Officers to take action on the representation dated 11.05.2023 submitted by the petitioner.

It is not in dispute that the father of the petitioner had filed a Civil Suit for permanent injunction on 21.01.2023 and vide order dated 01.04.2023, the interim injunction had been allowed in favour of the petitioner.

Against the violation of the interim order passed by the Civil Court and interference by the private respondent in the peaceful possession of the petitioner, an application has already been moved by the petitioner in the Civil Suit for seeking Police help for implementation of the order dated 01.04.2023 which has also been allowed vide order dated 04.11.2023 by the same Court.

It is submitted that notwithstanding the aforesaid order passed by the Civil Court, the respondents are still interfering in the peaceful possession for which a representation has been submitted on 11.05.2023, to the police officials.

Since the petitioner has already approached the Civil Court and the Civil Court is seized of the matter, the remedy against any violation/deficient assistance being provided by the authority or violation by the private respondents has to be arraigned in an appropriate application/proceedings before the Civil Court, itself.

Faced with the above, the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present writ petition so as to take recourse to an appropriate alternative remedy.

Disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
